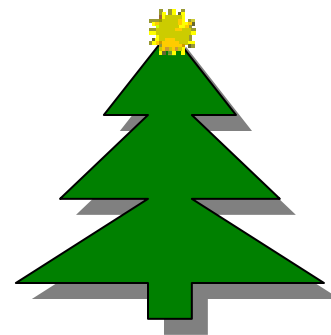

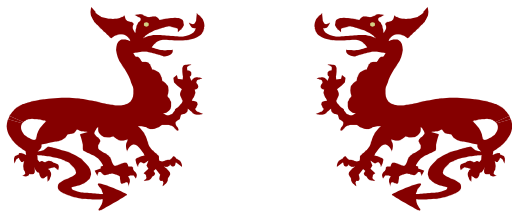

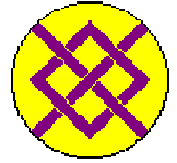
done this before!” When it came to the end, he assisted Pieter in the timing and holding of the notes so that Pieter as Director and the Glee Club actually ended at the same time!

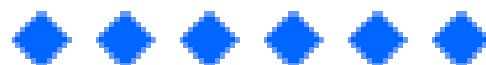
