Royal Recognition in the Barony of Rivenstar







Meeting Minutes for 10-10-16

11 Members in attendance

Event Reports:

Rocky talked about the demo two weeks ago at the Walnut School. John taught finger weaving during the school days at the Feast of the Hunters Moon.

Officer Reports:

Archery – We held our first Royal Round. Wilhelm will submit the scores online.

Chronicler – The quarterly report was submitted. The regional chronicler commented how much she liked the Territory by zip code page that was in the last newsletter. Katrin needs to fact check one thing and then she'll post the next newsletter online this Tuesday.

Announcements and Events:

Spring Event

- During the meeting, Gallien texted Pieter and let us know that the armory would be free as in zero dollars for the club to use for our event.
- We requested that he reserve April 29th as soon as possible. Once that site is reserved, we can use it for the Tournament of Chivalry, but we still need a site for feast.
- Their Royal Majesties asked us to host a TOC, but that doesn't mean we are locked into hosting it.
- The general consensus was to hold the TOC and have a smaller feast if needed to accommodate that lack of good sites we have available that have kitchen facilities.
- We discussed the number of tables and servers we need. A modest feast would be less than 100 people.
- We discussed the pros and cons of several event sites.
- The Vinton Woods Clubhouse and Jenks Rest will not work for what we need.
- Pieter will check into the YMCA and Knights of Columbus sites and Sigulf will check on the John Purdue Room.
- The other sites are just too far for people to travel for feast.
- Previous TOCs have received upwards of 450 people.
- The TOC and day camping will take up most of the space inside the Armory.
- We can reserve the woodsy area around the building for fair weather fencing and vigils (if needed.)
- No archery or thrown weapons will be offered as there is no room.
- Using the memorial mall was considered, but the armory is a better fit.
- Court will need to be held in the armory.
- We need to announce BYOChairs in the ads and event pages or spend the money renting chairs.
- We discussed possibly needing a sound system.
- We discussed parking and possible locations for troll.

- We won't be able to collect site fees, but we will collect donations instead.
- We can do the 50/50 event earnings split with Kingdom from the donation jar.
- Having the event on campus would be an excellent recruitment opportunity as well. We should post the event all over campus and be ready with an information booth to answer questions and explain what is happening at the TOC.
- We will need lots of signs to herd people to the correct locations.

Christmas Court

- Brianna is waiting for her contact person at the church to get back with her to give her the final deposit numbers so we can write a check.
- The site is being held for us for Dec 3rd.
- Katrin was inspired by the Dirty Dozen Largess Derby that was held at Crown Tourney. She has volunteered to organize a Half Dozen Derby for Christmas Court to build the baronial coffers.
- She will post the competition rules on the email list and Facebook. This can be a joint venture with the A&S Office and the Regalia Committee.
- Largess items are gifts made by the populous and given to the baron and baroness to hand out to members as rewards for service and accomplishments.

Spring Event

- There was a question of whether the TOC is replacing our regular Three Saints Spring event. Yes, it will be for 2017 as we are not holding two spring events.
- **Takaya reminded everyone that doing a Tournament of Chivalry is a service to the Kingdom. All of the baronies and shires in the Midrealm are expected to**

host Royal events like TOCs. We will be focusing on heavy fighting for this event to support our Crown and the Order of Chivalry.

- Other activities such as A&S and Archery are not being dismissed. In fact, we had been asked earlier this year to do a Bardic Madness in autumn next year which will be A&S heavy and will not likely have any heavy fighting.
- Pieter looked into the YWCA site for Feast. The kitchen is \$25 an hour. The dining hall is \$100 an hour. Since they are not open on Saturdays, we would need to pay one of their employees \$15.00 an hour to babysit the facility while we are in it.
- He is still going to check out the Presbyterian Church as it may be a better option for feast.
- Gallien confirmed that we cannot schedule the armory and its additional parts until the schedule opens up for all of the student organization groups to access the schedule. As usual, the Purdue admin is vague about when that will be. So far, April 29th is still open.
- Within the Armory, we want to reserve the main drill hall, the two classrooms, and the grassy areas around the building.
- The bathrooms are limited, so we discussed renting portable units.
- We discussed using either popup tents with covered walls inside the drill hall or using the classrooms as changing areas to avoid bathroom crowding.
- One of the two classrooms might be good for a royalty room or, if weather permits, we can set up one of our larger tents outside on the grassy area.
- Purdue allows 10X10 popup tents outside as long as they don't have stakes. Staked tents require an additional phone call to Purdue facilities. We discussed using the girl's dorm and the cook tent.
- There may be space for an artisan's row either in the lobby or outside under one of the tents.
- Troll might also be setup in the lobby.
- There will be limited space for pick up fights for fencing outside.
- We discussed parking and signs needed around campus.
- We shouldn't have a problem setting up a snack/drinks table for the fighters as long as we add it to the student org paperwork.

restrooms, men and women's locker rooms, a concession stand lunch area, and a bar lounge area. This field will hold the Tournament, day camping, troll, the royalty room, and possibly vendors.

- A&S displays may be possible, but there are no rooms for classes.

- Rental is \$120 per hour for the whole building, but we would only need this building until about 4:00 pm or so. (It's \$60 per side of the field. We want to use both halves for the tournament and the bar lounge is included with renting the whole building.)

- The field has Astro Turf and the building managers have expressed a no sugary drink rule on the soccer field itself. We will have to police this and enforce this rule during the tournament.

- We can have water on the field.

- All drink and food needs to be set up off the soccer field itself. There is an obvious demarcation line, so that should make it easier for people.

- We also need to request that the fighters not fight on their knees. That shouldn't be much of an issue with a TOC.

- The second indoor soccer field also has bathrooms and locker rooms, but it has a larger kitchen facility. This field will hold feast.

- We can use the kitchen area all day for free, but we would need to begin renting the half soccer field for feast at about 4:00 pm at \$60 an hour.

- We will need to use the tarps over the AstroTurf for the tables and chairs.

- The building managers have a deal with Midwest Rentals, so renting tables and chairs for feast shouldn't be overly expensive.

- The kitchen does not have an oven, but we can bring in crockpots and roasters. We can design the feast around the kitchen limitations.

- Parking should be adequate.

- The event will be indoors regardless of the weather since using the outdoor space is an additional fee and not large.

- The managers would prefer if we didn't offer drinks to the fighters as they have a concession stand. It's how they make money.

- Since many of the fighters will be bringing their own Gatorade type energy drinks, it was suggested that Pieter negotiate some kind of deal with the managers about this issue.

- It's no problem to offer pickles and such since they don't sell those.

### Youth Activities

- There was a lot of chatter on Facebook about the rules for being a Youth marshal and needing a marshal for all official children's activities including demos.

- Brianna clarified the rules. Nothing has changed.

- The SCA pays for the background check for those wanting to be group Youth marshals and "At-Large"

marshals for any event so it is free for anyone who is interested in herding Scadian spawn.

- You must go through the SCA. You cannot use your own work related background check credentials.

- Ursus already went through the SCA process and is now qualified.

How Do I Use Facebook in the SCA: The Basics

First, you will need a Facebook account. Go to www.facebook.com to sign up. Follow the instructions to create your own account.

Choosing a Profile Name:

You can either use your SCA name or your mundane name as your Facebook profile name. If you plan to use your account to connect with family and friends, I'd recommend using your given name. If you use your Facebook account primarily for SCA related socializing, then use the name people will know you as.

Facebook does give you the option to add a nickname which shows up on your profile page in parenthesis; however, it does not appear when you post on other people's feeds. Only your main name shows up. This nickname is useful if you do both mundane and SCA socializing on Facebook. People can search for either of your names and still find you online.

Warning: Facebook has been picky about unusual names and may reject something like Pinkersnoddy the Pale as a real profile name. If your SCA name is a bit on the theatrical side, your best bet is to use your real name and add your SCA name as a nickname.

Barony of Rivenstar Group Page:

Once you have set up your account and profile, you can join the Rivenstar group page. Enter Rivenstar into the search box or have someone in the Barony send you an invite. This is the direct link as well: <https://www.facebook.com/groups/206074996086793/>

Posts and Comments:

There are several ways to get information once you have joined the group. The most obvious way is by looking at your Discussion feed. This is the list of posts you'll see as you scroll down the page. You can read the post, click on the comments section to read what other people have posted, or join in the conversation by clicking Comment and typing in a reply message. You can add a general comment or you can reply specifically to someone's comment.

Posting Documents, Videos, and Pictures

You can either post pictures to your own photo albums or post them to the group page. If you are planning to post more than two or three pictures, I'd recommend creating a photo album on your personal profile page and then sharing that album to the group page. That way the photos are always accessible to you if the group page is ever deleted for some reason.

Baronial specific documents like meeting minutes or room schedules can be uploaded as files to the group page. There is a separate tab that allows you to see all of the documents posted to the group page.

Facebook Events:

If you have a class or meeting you would like people to know about, you can create a Facebook event within the Rivenstar group page. Choose Create Event and fill out the necessary information. This event will be shared to all group members automatically. You can invite Facebook users from outside the group as well.

Once you have created a Rivenstar Facebook event, that event page will have its own post feed that people can post and comment on that is separate from the main group posting feed.

Posting Etiquette:

Always think before you post a response to someone's post. Read everything through before you reply. Insulting or derogatory language will not be tolerated. SCA groups are normally heavily moderated, so we don't often have too many issues, but there are mean spirited people out there that just seem to thrive off of being rude and cruel. Don't be that person.

If someone's comments to your posts are threatening or inappropriate, you can report them to Facebook or to the moderators of the group page. Try your best to avoid engaging the poster until the moderators take action.

Private Messaging:

If you want to contact the person who wrote a post or if you have a private question that you don't want to post publically, there is a lovely feature called Facebook Messaging. If you click on the person's profile name, it directs you to their profile page.

Somewhere near their profile name will be an option to send them a message. Facebook likes to change stuff all the time, so just look for the word Message or a picture of an envelope. Write your message and hit send. Not everyone uses Facebook the same way, so if they don't reply, try posting on the Rivenstar group page that you want to get ahold of them privately.

And remember, not everyone is going to have the same level of computer experience as you do, so be as patient and chivalrous online as you are on the field or on the dance floor!
