# Baronial Business Meeting Minutes

**Mounted War Games** in the Barony of Shadowed Stars - Gunnarr was made a member of the Greenwood Company and Katrin was made a member of the Order of the Dragons Barb. Both awards were for exemplary service and skill for Archery/Thrown Weapons.

**Mosey Demo** - This was the last Mosey of the year. We were located on 9th and Main Street this time and seemed to do better without the extremely loud music on 11th street.

**Missile Weapons Collegium** - The event went well with no injuries or major problems. We had archery, thrown weapons, combat archery, and siege activities as well as classes and lots of food and socialization.

- 'Coise (Exchequer) is still compiling receipts and the event report. If you have receipts, get them to her ASAP. Ray was issued a check during the event for the meat and smoking supplies.

- There were 33 cars in the parking lot (Takaya's front yard) with 65 total spots. We estimated that about 130 people in 65 cars might be the limit for parking in that area.

- We estimated 50 people for our lunch preparations. There wasn't much left over so 50 was a good guess.

- We didn't have any campers, but the early morning volunteers appreciated the breakfast Nan made.

- We sold 34 dinner tickets (not including extra sandwiches sold). We used 3 of the pork butts and 4 chickens for dinner. We sold 5 of the 8 whole pork butts and still had some left over pork and chicken. Everyone was well fed. There were plenty of snacks left over from breakfast and lunch plus we had homemade ice cream for dessert.

- We used the cook tent and the Napatorium for food service and A&S classes. We had 4 tables with bench seating for 8 people each. We used all 5 of the PENNSIC tables with one additional table provided privately. This seemed to work out well.

- We had lots of new people. Rocky handed out 12 pieces of loaner garb.

- The idea was brought up to do this event again. If we do this event next year, we suggest no camping and we should try to find another weekend that is not opposite a long standing event like Harvest Days.

- The Hospitality tent experiment went well. People appreciated having the changing tents and snacks.

Katrin suggested moving the changing tents closer to the port-o-potties to give them higher visibility and having the water cooler closer to the snacks.

## Current Business:

**Next Business Meeting** will be September 23rd in STEWART 204. The 1st and 3rd Monday schedule will resume in October.

**Fighter practices at the Armory** – Purdue cancelled our reservations for the semester because the armory is now closed to everyone except the ROTC. We will be investigating new sites for Wednesday fighter practices. For now, we will be at Slayter Hill as long as the weather holds. This means we will not be able to hold winter archery in the Armory.

**A&S Nights** will be returning next month - Dates TBA

**Electronic Communication** - Pieter brought up the idea of using Facebook as our primary method of communication. We currently use both Facebook and our google email list. We have a Twitter account, but we don't actively use it for Baronial communication. (It was used more for student recruiting.) We also use the Meet Up app to post meetings and practices to gain local interest. There were arguments for using Facebook only and arguments to continue to use both FB and email. There are many people who don't like using Facebook, but the SCA now uses Facebook for official communication and posting event information. No decisions were made, but we will continue the conversation at another meeting.

**Feast Guidelines Planning Meeting** – Last Monday a group of people met to discuss ideas about future feast planning. Here is a summary of proposed changes from that meeting:

1. Making changes to how the budget is handled. Previously, members have paid for food and supplies out of pocket and submitted receipts to the exchequer for reimbursement.

*Problems:* Not everyone can front money for large quantities of food. There is no accountability for what people are spending and if purchases are within the budget.

*Proposed change:* The feast-o-crat would be given a check for the full budget up front to make purchases

and reimburse staff directly. The feast-o-crat would collect and submit all receipts, and any remaining funds would be returned to the exchequer.

2. Increasing feast ticket prices to meet rising food cost demands.

3. Implementing a children's menu for picky eaters by adding kid friendly food.

4. Only charging half price for children's feast tickets as they are not likely to eat everything on the feast menu. A suggested ratio of feast tickets sold was 70 adult and 10 children's tickets.

5. Holding feast tasting/planning meetings much earlier in the year to allow for menu planning and getting ingredients list on the website in a timely manner. November was suggested.

6. Including cost estimates with sample dishes so the feast-o-crat has an idea what each dish might cost.

**Youth Officer** – Per Society rules, whenever we hold demos involving youth we must have an authorized youth officer present. This includes doing school demos especially if the Chatelaine includes them in her official report. We discussed what we would need to comply with SCA law. Announcements & New Business:

Change to Marshal Reporting – the Kingdom Earl Marshal has requested that only the Deputy Earl Marshals, regional marshals, and group marshals use the Services Portal for their Domesday reports. If you are a Marshal at Large or a Marshal in Training (MIT), please send your Domesday reports to your local group marshals and they will include your information in their report.

Change to Society Law Concerning Marijuana Use – Because marijuana use is now legal in some states, the SCA policy on marijuana has changed. Summary: Follow the local and state laws regarding use and respect event sites restrictions. The SCA requests members show courtesy when smoking and vaping as people may have allergies and sensitivities.

Youth Officer at Demos – Gunnarr read the email response she received about Youth officer requirements for youth demos. Summary: We must have an authorized group Youth officer or Youth

Officer-at large present whenever we are participating in a school or other demo for children. There is a separate background check so Youth Authorized Marshals will need to fill out the additional paperwork. Gunnarr will not be renewing her authorization. If you attend school demos or help out with running children's activities, please consider becoming a Youth Officer-at large.

— Zilia would like to offer a few free feast tickets for those who wish to "Sing for Their Supper". We discussed the various ways to judge and present the performances during the day or during feast. We will ask the queen if she would like to be involved in the judging.

— Feast tickets are \$12.00.

— Kids 12 and under will have their own menu and their tickets are \$6.00 each.

— We are offering off board seating. Space is limited, so people can sign up for the open tables. Site officially closes at 10:30 pm. We discussed the practicality of bardic activities after feast.

- Site Tokens - We have 190 rapier pendant site tokens that we didn't use from the last TOD. We discussed ordering more swords and what we could use to hang them. We might have enough time to do individual kumihimo braids. Brianna will make samples in different colors for next meeting.
- We discussed different ideas for feast tokens, but no decisions were made.
- Encara will contact Mathildis about a card design.
- Sigulf will serve as the Merchant coordinator.
- Wilhelm will coordinate Archery and Thrown Weapons. He can MIC either one, but not both and Katrin will be busy with the charity drives. He will contact other marshals to see who can help out.

- Registration/Site Fee will be \$17.00 with a member discount of \$5.00. Children 17 and under will be free this year to encourage more families to attend.

Members of the Order of the Silver Acorn bear the Baronial Arms with a silver acorn superimposed upon the riven star.




### Order of the Defender of Rivenstar
