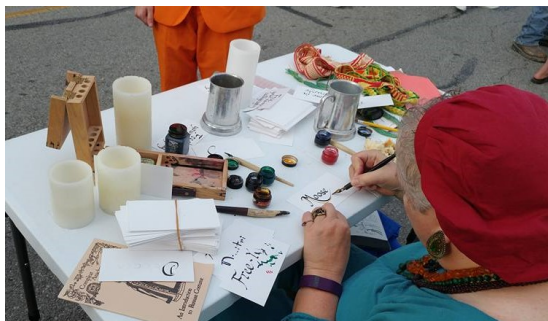

Rivenstar Invades Lafayette!

In an effort to reach out to the Lafayette locals, we participated in Mosey Down Main Street for the first time. Mosey is a free once a month summer festival that begins in May and ends in September. We registered for a table and got a warm welcome from the Mosey coordinators and the community.

Many of the local Hoosiers were amazed to hear we've been here for 40 years. This isn't surprising since we spend most of our time on Purdue campus recruiting students who tend to leave after they graduate. If our barony is going to thrive, we need motivated members who are a stable part of our community.

It didn't take long for people to flock to our table. Some wanted to know if we were affiliated with the Renaissance Faire, while others were attracted to the sound of rattan whacking against armor. Twelve barony members came out for the June and August Moseys. We answered lots of great questions and handed out bookmarkers with our contact information and activities schedule.

During the June Mosey, the WLFI cameraman stopped by and filmed Adhamh and Sigulf demonstrating heavy combat moves. Rocky was featured doing calligraphy at the picnic table near our booth. 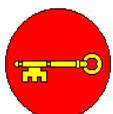

Officer Reports:

Madrigals - On hiatus until classes begin.

Chronicler - The May/Jun edition of the newsletter is finished and on the website and Facebook.

Archery - We are having practice Thursday and Sunday next week weather permitting. We had lots of interest in archery during Mosey.

Seneschal - Brianna sent in her report, all is well in the barony.

Webminister - Finishing up the paperwork to change officers. Ursus will be the new Webminister.

Equestrian - We had a great practice on Sunday. (See Facebook for information updates for the Indianapolis practices.)

Exchequer - The May report came in today. We still have 2 t-shirts that have not been paid for. We need to get that money in before we can close out that account and move funds to the student org account.

Baron/Baroness - Lots of good stories about Mosey.

New Business and Announcements:

Mosey Down Main Street

- People loved the book markers. We have plenty left to do several more Mosey events.
- Lots of pictures and the WLFI TV18 link were added to Facebook.
- We made a list of things we would like to improve upon for the August Mosey.
- We definitely need a sign that says Rivenstar. Katrin volunteered to get the materials and create a sign similar to the one we use as the gate sign for PENNSIC.
- We discussed lighting options since we have no access to electricity.
- The new banners were nice, but we should consider arranging them differently. Brianna took the banners home with her to use for 50th Year coming up in a few weeks.
- The next Mosey we signed up for is the last Saturday of PENNSIC, so we need to know who all is going to be available for that event.

Baronial Document Scanning

- During the annual baronial inventory May 29th, Dani

asked what we wanted to do with the tub of A&S records she had in storage. Katrin and Francoise offered to scan the documents. Katrin took the tub home and started sorting the documents for scanning.

- The documents in the tub date back to 1980. They are yellowed and moldy. Katrin recommended we get rid of all the reports and only save some of the artwork and A&S submissions relative to the barony's history. She will check with our current A&S Minister Aurora to see what she wants to do with the paper copies.

- Brianna checked with her regional to find out how long the Seneschal's records need to be stored. Hard copy is best, but we can get rid of old paperwork if we save it digitally. We should keep paper documents for at least 7 years.

- On Facebook, Aurora said she will check with her regional to see how to deal with old records.

- Katrin asked about cloud storage for the electronic copies. We need to discuss this further as it would be a good idea to consolidate all of the baronial records someplace we can all access them if needed.

- Some of the historically interesting documents like the three saints reliquary documentation will be posted to the website for everyone to see.

Colombian Park Demo/Practice?

- There was some chatter on Facebook about branching out into the community to get more exposure. One of the ideas was have an occasional fighter practice at Columbian Park in Lafayette. Briana will contact the Park and Rec department to get more details.

- We also need to discuss this with our marshals to see if the fighters want to have any additional practices or have a change of scenery once a month.

- We will have the Napatorium but we won't need the benches. BYO camp chairs and utility tables.

- Nan and Pieter are bringing a small fire pit for social gathering but not for cooking. BYO camp stoves. We are not having a cook group. BYO food. Food vendors will be on site as well.

- There will be a list of what to bring/SCA camping suggestions posted to Facebook.

NOTE: Since most of the officers and Their Excellencies will be at 50th year, we will NOT have a formal business meeting June 20th.
