Meeting Minutes for 4-30-18

(Includes the information from the short meeting on 4-23-18)

Officer Reports

Seneschal – Brianna sent the baronial officers a list of questions to fill out that she had received from the Kingdom Seneschal. If you did not receive the email, let her know and she can update your contact information.

Herald – Jacob sent in his report.

Chatelaine - Rocky sent in her report.

Baron – The report will be sent in this week.

Katrin is working on getting new bookmarks printed.
We discussed volunteering and bringing highly visual items to display or demonstrate at the demo.

- Rocky will run the booth for the June 2nd Mosey.

Mathildis' Banner Project

- (Aka Arrantxa) has offered to put together an order for banners to display our individual or household heraldry. There are various sizes to choose from. You can paint them yourself or have her paint them for you. There are several threads on Facebook about the topic or send your requests for information to her via the email list.

We also discussed if we want to have three larger banners with the Three Saints painted on them for regalia. There were questions of cost and who is going to store it. I honestly don't know if we made a decision on it or not, so let's just say it was tabled for next meeting.
Encara also wants to work on collecting the history of the barony so it is on paper somewhere.

Post Three Saints Wrap up

- Encara handed back items from the lost and found bin.

- Troll 277 Adults, 10 Children, 1 Family Cap, 8 under 5
- 77 feast tickets sold
- 121 people were served at the Lunch tavern

- Rocky handed the fundraising money from the Lunch Tavern to Gunnar who then handed it to the Exchequer to use for archery equipment.

- 3 combat archery authorizations
- 89 fencers
- Ullr won the spear tournament.

- Gunnar won the Largess Derby. Katrin handmade a stuffed felt dragon for the prize.

- Gregory struck over 300 coins since he was not able to get all of the swords for site tokens. We agreed to pay

him his original asking price for the swords. We will keep the partial shipment of swords for use next year. His Excellency was given the remaining site token coins for use as largess.

Things to work on for next year's event:

- We will add a disclaimer to the seating chart letting people know that seating is subject to change. Since we did not sell out feast, 'Coise consolidated one of the tables and had to deal with an inflexible and irate individual.

- The table cloths are getting grungy. 'Coise is looking into buying new ones.

- We discussed the Troll back up issues and ways to help make troll move faster. It's not often that we hold large events like this, so this may not be an issue at a regular event.

- We decided to bring back the table menus with the ingredients listed on them. Apparently, the various ingredients list posted around the site and on the website was not sufficient. There was an allergy issue at feast that was addressed but did not require further medical attention.

- We are going to look into getting ant-fatigue mats for the kitchen.

- There were a number of communication breakdowns during tear down. Encara is making a list of issues to address for next year to make tear down more efficient. - We discussed trimming down inventory and going through the regalia items that no one knows we have.
